Vocabulary From 1 John 1:4,5

οὗτος, αὕτη, τοῦτο – (demonstrative pronoun) – this

γράφω – (verb) – I write

ἵνα – (conj. + Subj.) – in order that, that – (usually indicates a purpose clause)

χαρά, χαρᾶς, ἡ - (noun) – joy

πληρώω – (verb) – I fill; I fulfill, complete

ἀγγελία, -ας, ἡ - (noun) – message, news

ἀναγγέλω – (verb) - I bring back tidings; report; rehearse

ὅτι – (conjunction) – that, since, because. (Can also be used to indicate direct discourse.)

θεός, -οῦ, ὁ and ἡ - (noun) – god, goddess, a deity; God

φῶς, φωτός, τό - (noun) – light

σκοτία, σκοτίας, ἡ - (noun) – darkness

οὐ, οὐκ, οὐχ – (negative particle) – not, no

οὐδείς, οὐδεμία, οὐδέν – (negative particle + adjective) - no one, nothing; “but not one”
