## Vocabulary For I John 2

- 2:8 πάλιν – (adverb) - again  
ἀληθής, -ές – (adjective) – true, real, genuine, honest (from alpha privative α = not + λήθω = I overlook; I do not see or notice; hence ἀληθής = not unobserved)  
παράγω – (verb) – I pass by, pass on, pass away  
ἀληθινός, -ή, -όν – (adjective) – true, real, genuine  
ἤδη – (adverb) - now, already  
φαίνω – (verb) – I shine
- 2:9 ἀδελφός, -οῦ, ὁ – (noun) – brother  
μισέω - (verb) – I hate; disregard, am indifferent to  
ἕως – (conjunction; or preposition + gen.) – until; as far as, to the point of  
ἄρτι – (adverb) - now, at the present time
