Vocabulary For I John 3

- 3:19 ἐμπροσθεν – (prep. + genitive) – before; in the presence of
πείθω – (verb) – I persuade, convince (aor. ἐπεισα)
καρδία, -ας, ἡ – (noun) – heart; met., inner self
- 3:20 καταγινώσκω – (verb) – I condemn, accuse (lit., experientially-know-against)
μείζων, -ον – (adjective of comparison of μέγας) – greater
