Vocabulary For I John 3

- 3:3 ἐλπίς, -ΐδος, ἡ – (noun) – hope; expectation
ἀγνίζω – (verb) – I purify; cleanse
ἀγνός, -ή, -όν – (adjective) – pure, holy; chaste
- 3:4 ἀνομία, -ας, ἡ – (noun) – lawlessness (lit., “without law”, either through ignorance or rebellion)
- 3:5 αἴρω – (verb) – I take, bring; take away; lead; carry
